The Diploma in Financial Services is awarded on successful completion of all Part 1 & Part 2 subjects.

### **Program Objectives**

- a) To provide students with the appropriate body of commercial, economic and financial knowledge which they will require for employment in the financial Services sector i.e. Co-operatives, Risk Analyst & Insurance.
- b) To prepare students for a variety of functions within organizations providing Financial Services.
- c) To provide students with a qualification which will enable them to progress to higher level of academic and career levels and related degree Studies and degree studies in related areas.

**Recommended course Duration:** one academic year of full – time study for each part at an ICM Approved Centre. Students must complete all subjects in Part 1 before commencing Part 2.

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:** The minimum age for registration for this program is 18.

Applicants should note that the following entrance qualifications are recommended for those wishing to undertake this program:

1. The Business Studies Group Certificate
  2. One GCE/A-level
  3. Five GCEs at grades A, B or C (including Maths and English)
  4. A suitable BTEC National Award or GNVQ Advanced
- Any qualifications equivalent to one of the above
