

## **MASTERY OF MANAGEMENT DIPLOMA IN MONEY, BANKING AND FINANCIAL SYSTEMS**

This program sets out the theoretical, analytical and practical aspects and gives a full insight into the purposes, roles and features of money, banks, banking financial systems and markets and their function and importance in financial and economic activity.

The program considers both traditional issues of monetary policy and the independence of central banks, and also the more recent issues such as the transparency with which central banks conduct monetary policy.

Money, banking and financial systems comprehensively covers the roles of financial systems and introduces financial institutions; it looks at interest rates and asset valuation, money supply and demand, monetary policy and the main types of financial markets.

On successfully completing this program of study students will:
